OUR ACTIVITIES

Our members' interests are often far from mainstream! We aim to adapt typical youth club activities to fit with our children's special interests and sensory preferences. Some of our current and planned activities include:

Younger members: playpark playdates; sensory and messy play activities; fun-based sessions with therapeutic support to promote social skills and play.

Primary age children: arts and crafts; drama and music; games nights; Lego club; Minecraft Network; Pokemon community day.

Teen club: games night; cinema club; day trips to special interest activities; drama; hiking; themed events.

Parents and supporters: volunteer training; mentor development; invited speakers; tea, chats and mutual support.
